## **The Anointing for Your Feet**

The last letter of the Hebrew alphabet is taw. To the Jewish people it represents truth. The letter taw looked like a cross during the time of Ezekiel. Ezekiel 9:4 makes reference to a "mark on the forehead". This word mark in Hebrew is spelled with two letters: waw and taw. Waw is a nail. Taw is a cross. That is the mark with which God's people are set apart. In another picture, the brass serpent was erected to save the people who were bitten by snakes. The word for serpent has three Hebrew letters. The word for brass (symbolizing judgment) has the same three letters with the letter taw added to it. Hallelujah, we are delivered from judgment and the powers of evil because of the cross of Jesus Christ.

I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring[e] and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel. Genesis 3:15

When Mary Magdalene anointed Jesus' feet, it was a sign that His feet would crush the enemy. Why are feet important? When you have the armor of God (Ephesians 6:15) you need a base or foundation to carry the armor. Roman soldiers had sandals that were studded with hobnails to help them stand. When you stand, Lord will crush the enemy under your feet. A number of passages about feet also make reference to the Gospel of peace. Beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel (Romans 10:15). Preaching the Gospel is connected to what comes out of your mouth. The gospel declares that man does not have to pay for his righteousness because it was done by Jesus Christ on the cross. We are saved by faith. A sign of your feet being anointed is when you start speaking words of faith and lifting up Jesus Christ. Contrary to what others are saying, you declare, "My God reigns". What is the gospel of peace? Peace is God holding everything together in a harmonious fashion. Every aspect of life becomes wholesome - physical, spiritual, financial, relational - everything is held together. When you have anointed feet, you will tread on the high places (Habakkuk 3:19). In the Old Testament high places were places where satanic worship was held. The enemy says worship belongs to him, but God gives us the anointing to take over the high places.

The blessing of Asher involves shoes of iron (stability) and brass (judgment). He needs this blessing because Asher is the main tribe on the northern border of Israel. He needs a solid base to deal with the Philistines. God is giving us an anointing on our feet – this anointing will crush the powers of darkness. Keep your eyes open to see miracles. Asher also had an anointing to bring counsel and blessing to those in authority. Asher influenced rulers. Why did Asher get this anointing? He was the eighth son. Eight is connected to oil. Do you want an anointing on your feet to crush the enemy and to

conquer the high places? Your feet will take possession of everything within the boundaries that God has given you because of the anointing of your feet. Just as Jesus Christ was anointed to crush the enemy, God is releasing an anointing over people to crush the powers of darkness. The enemy will not be able to pass through while you are entering the fulfillment of God's plan for your life. Through your walk of faith, you will take possession of your promise.
